Problematics

Based on NMAA data for the period February 24, 2022 - March 14, 2025) at least 1,148 civilians (around 10% are children) have been affected by ERW, 332 of them have died.

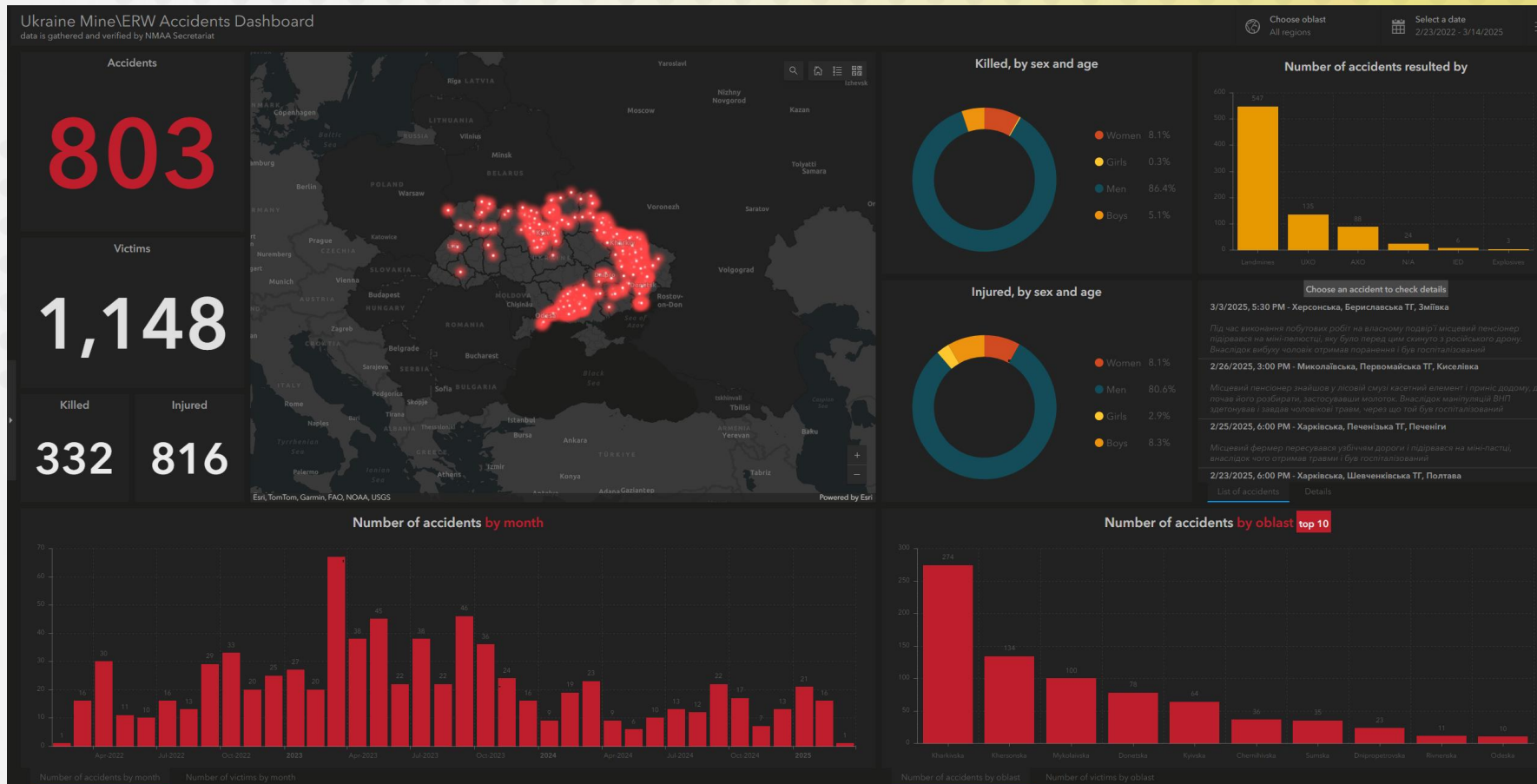


The largest number of cases occurred in following regions: Kharkiv, Kherson, Mykolaiv, Donetsk and Kyiv oblasts.

The actual figures are considerably higher due to underreporting and limited access to the areas of active hostilities.

It is obvious that Ukraine is the most contaminated country in the world.

Contaminated territories have a huge social-economic impact on Ukraine

To unite, consolidate and increase the potential of the best experts in Ukraine in the field of mine action (MA).



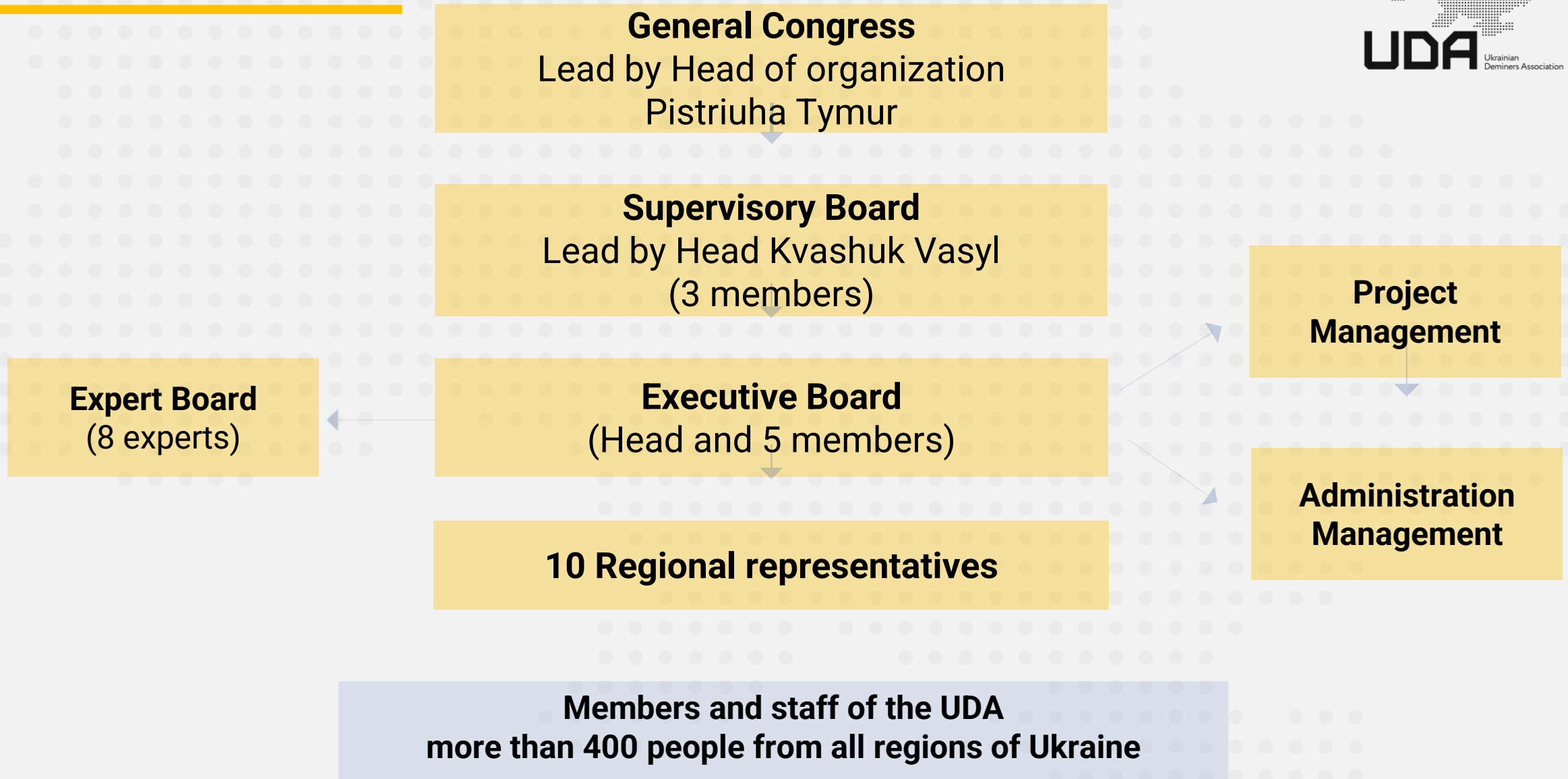

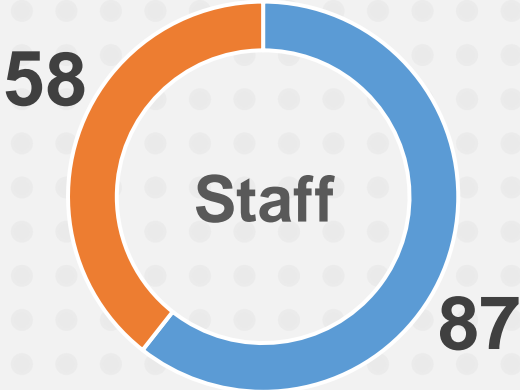
To consolidate efforts of civil society, the state, the media and international partners to create appropriate working conditions, technical support and protection of Ukrainian deminers.

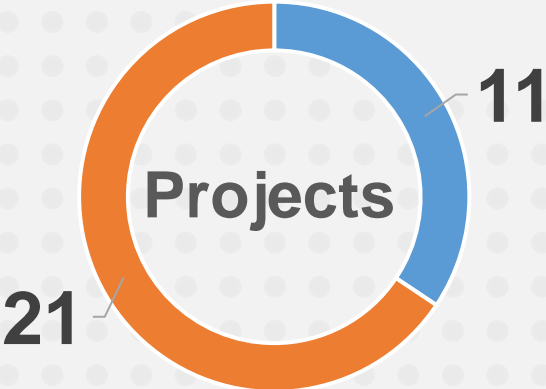
Structure

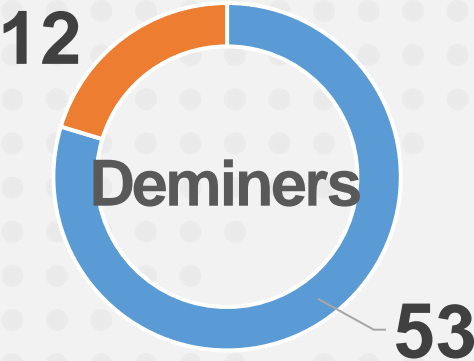

1. The UDA is biggest Ukrainian certified mine action operator. Since 2018 in mine action
2. The UDA is a permanent member UN Protection Cluster, UN Mine Action AOR, UN Food Security and Livelihood Cluster, Cash Working Group, UN Education Cluster, UN Health Cluster etc.
3. The UDA active takes part in the all main MA activities (meetings, round tables, conferences and more) under international organization (UNMAS, UNDP, OSCE, GICHD, etc.) and (MoD, Ministry of Economy, MRTOT, MES, State Border Guard, etc.);
4. Members of the UDA are part of various working groups to solve state issues in MA sphere (in particular, lawmakers process). Since the 5th of April 2024 UDA is Co-Chair in MA AOR.
5. The UDA is listed in the database of the MA organizations of the Geneva International Center for Humanitarian Demining (<https://www.gichd.org/en/resources/organisations/>).



Mine Action Operator

- ✓ UDA is certified mine action operator (number 3 in the list of NMAA) and the biggest Ukrainian mine action NGO.
- ✓ Currently, UDA possesses EORE, NTS, TS, Manual Clearance and BAC certificates.
- ✓ UDA is planning to continue certification process, especially related to mechanical clearance and MDD.



International cooperation



- The development of international cooperation is one of the main directions of the UDA.
- UDA takes part in all international events dedicated to humanitarian mine action.
- There is also experience in organizing an international conference, in particular conference "Military-Technical Cooperation between Ukraine and Croatia on the Mechanical Clearance. Experience, Status and Prospects", defense exhibition "SECURITY 2.0" and others.

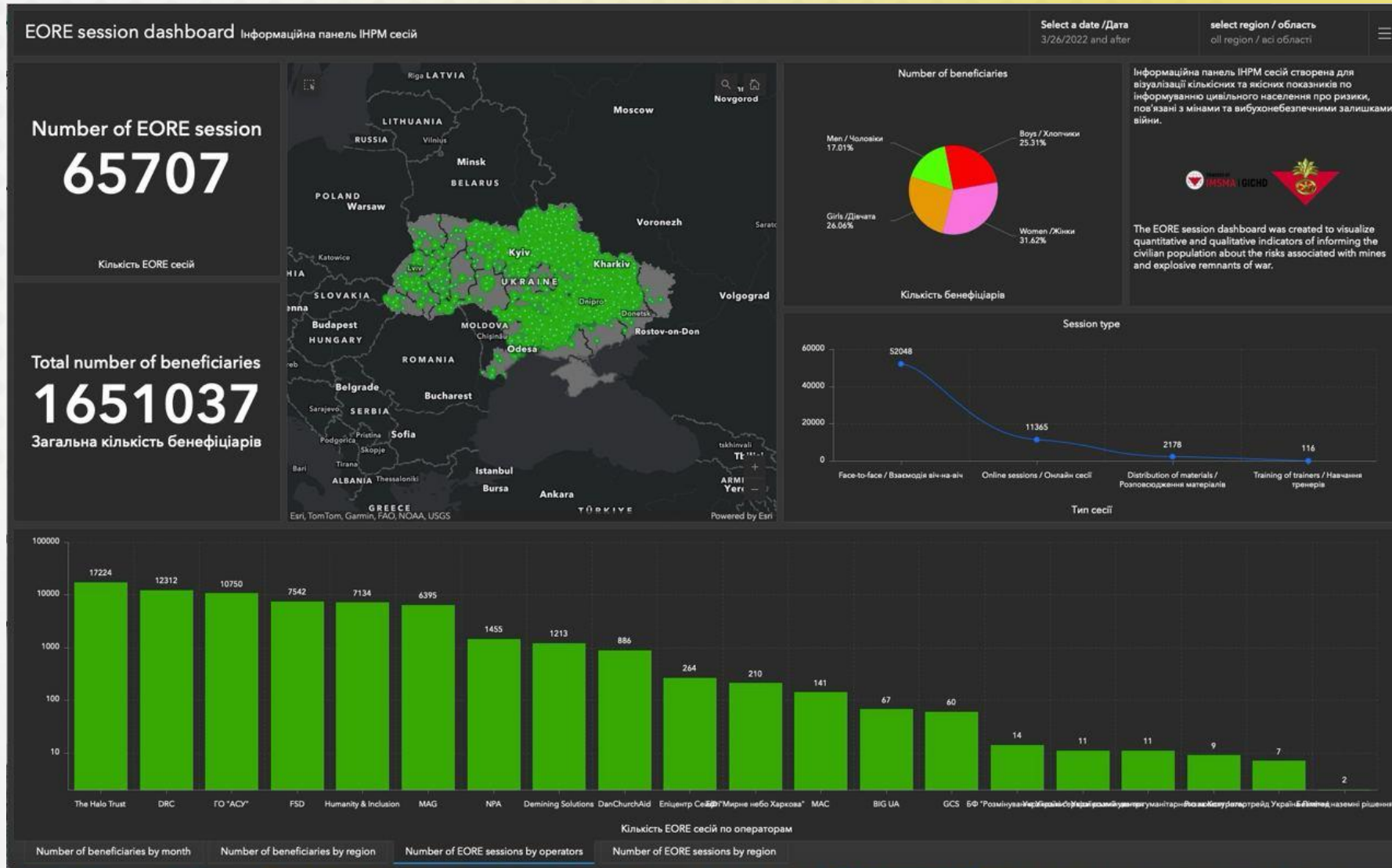

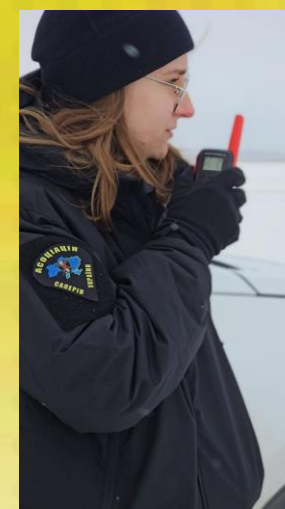
Humanitarian Demining

Directly after receiving NTS, TS, MMC, BAC certificates in MAC (Chernihiv) MoD UDA started HD operations

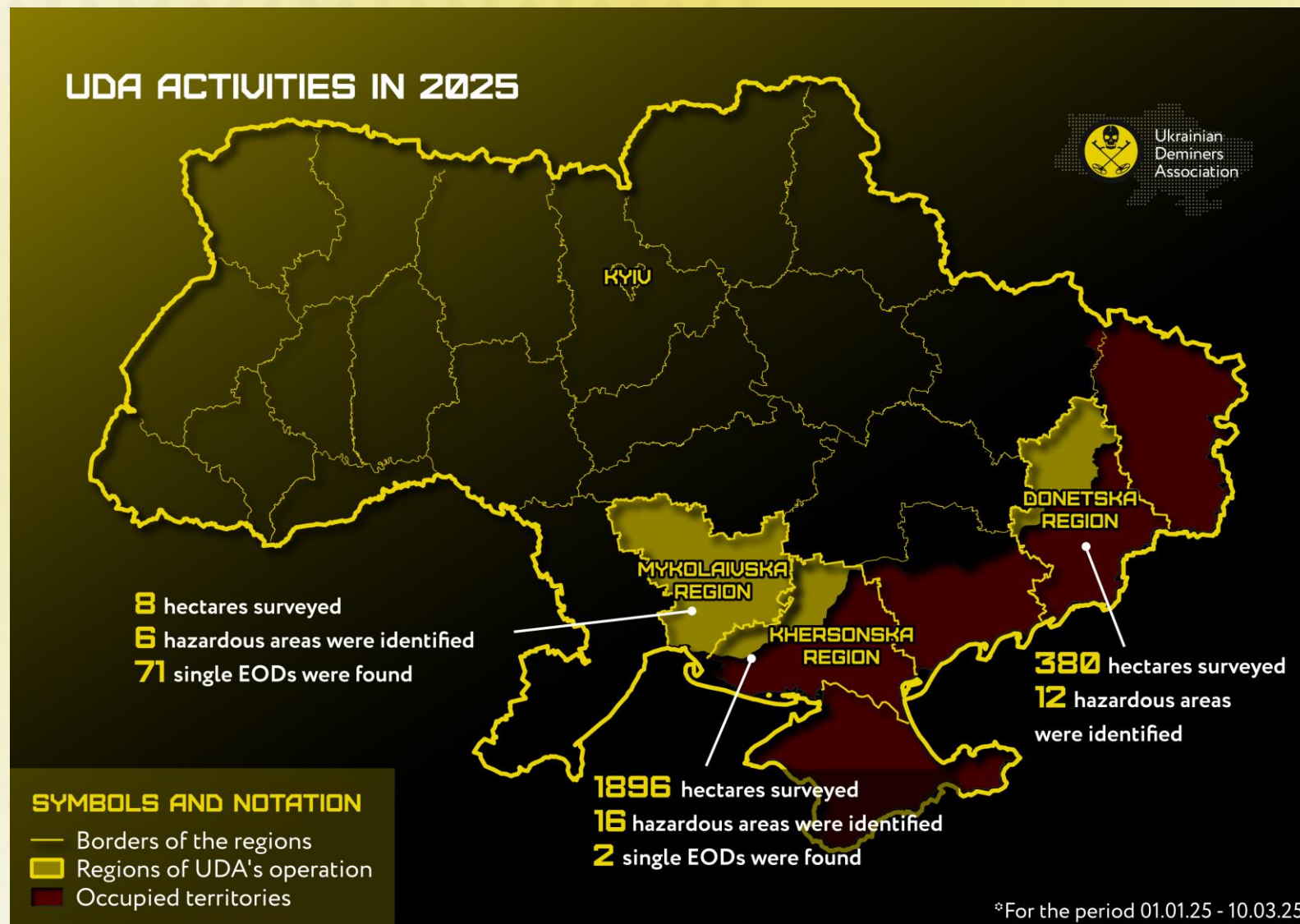
Currently, UDA deployed 6 NTS Teams and 5 clearance teams

Inclusivity

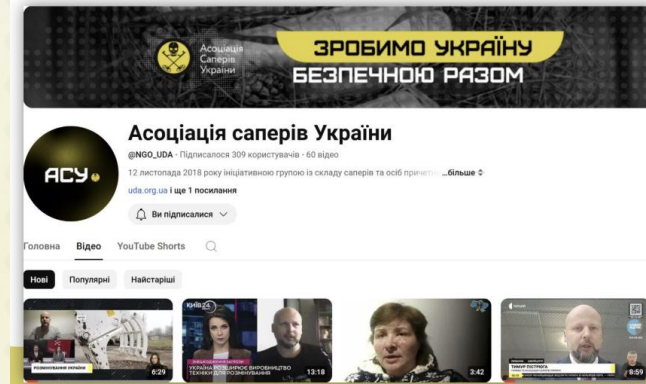
- Video lessons on EORE with sign interpretation for children and adults with **hearing impairments or total hearing loss**. Video lessons can be viewed on a separate page of our website.

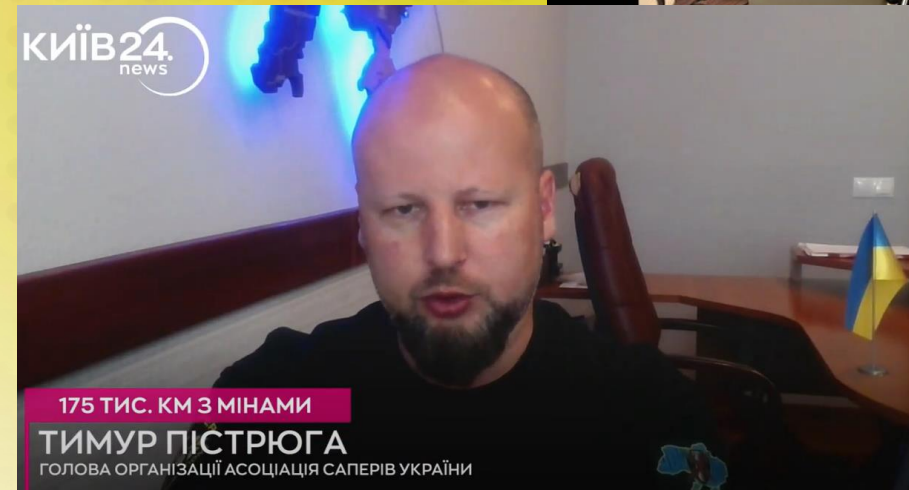

UDA Strategic Plan for next 3 years



- Achieve more sustainable and comprehensive humanitarian projects for medium and long-term perspective.
- Continue UDA's Capacity Building in cooperation with donors/partners from different continents.
- Expand UDA's certification processes as mine action operator.

Scale up the activities for 3 main directions:

1. Humanitarian Demining, including by means of MDDs, EOD Robotic System, Drone Systems, etc.
2. EORE campaign throughout Ukraine as well as in combination with CPP and First Aid.
3. Complex MVA including MHPSS and Legal Counseling with the main aim - reintegration victims into normal life.
