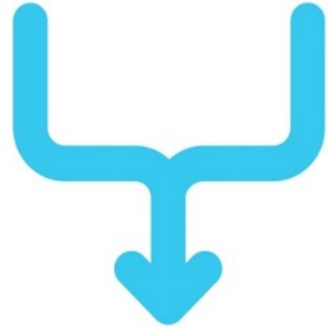

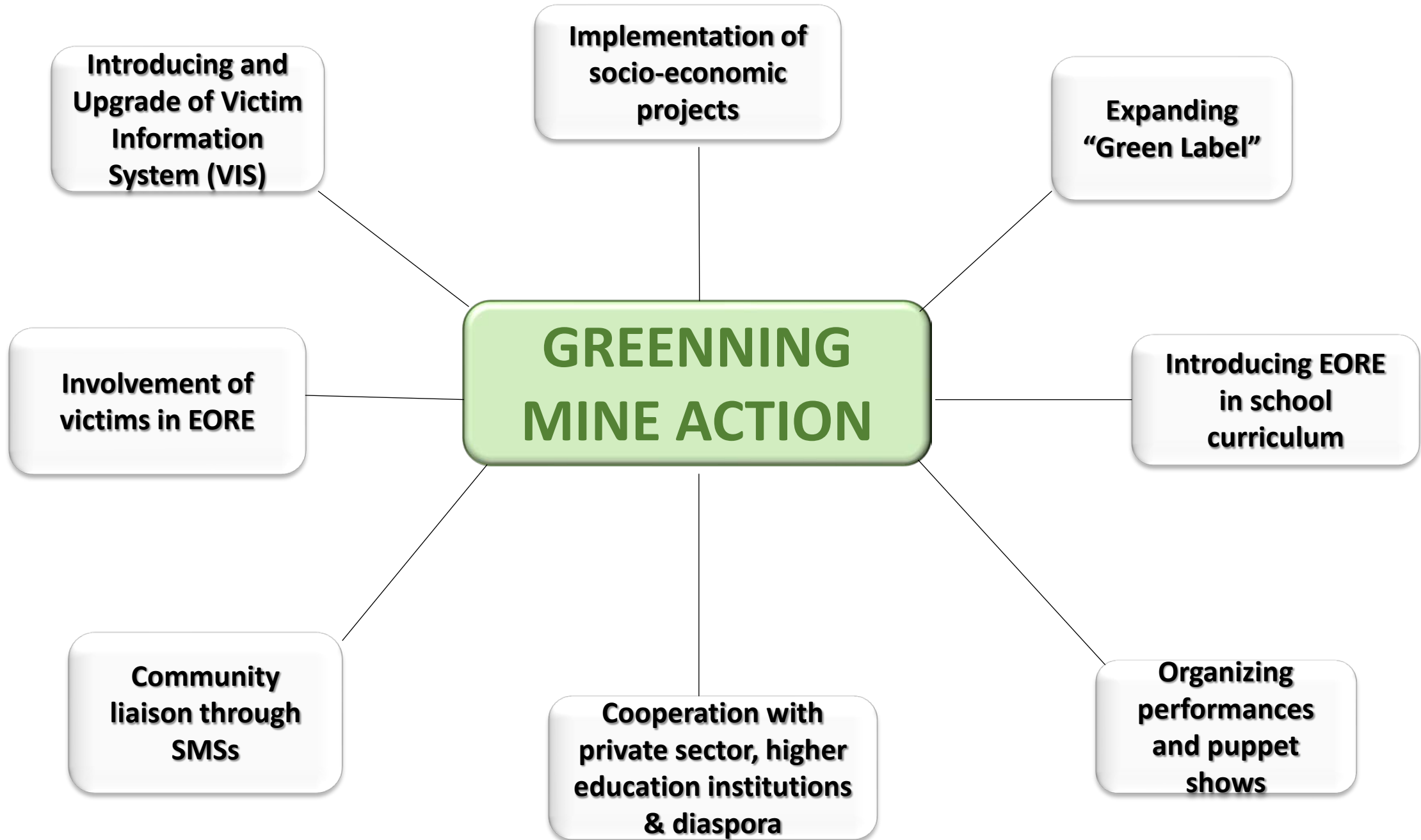

COOPERATION

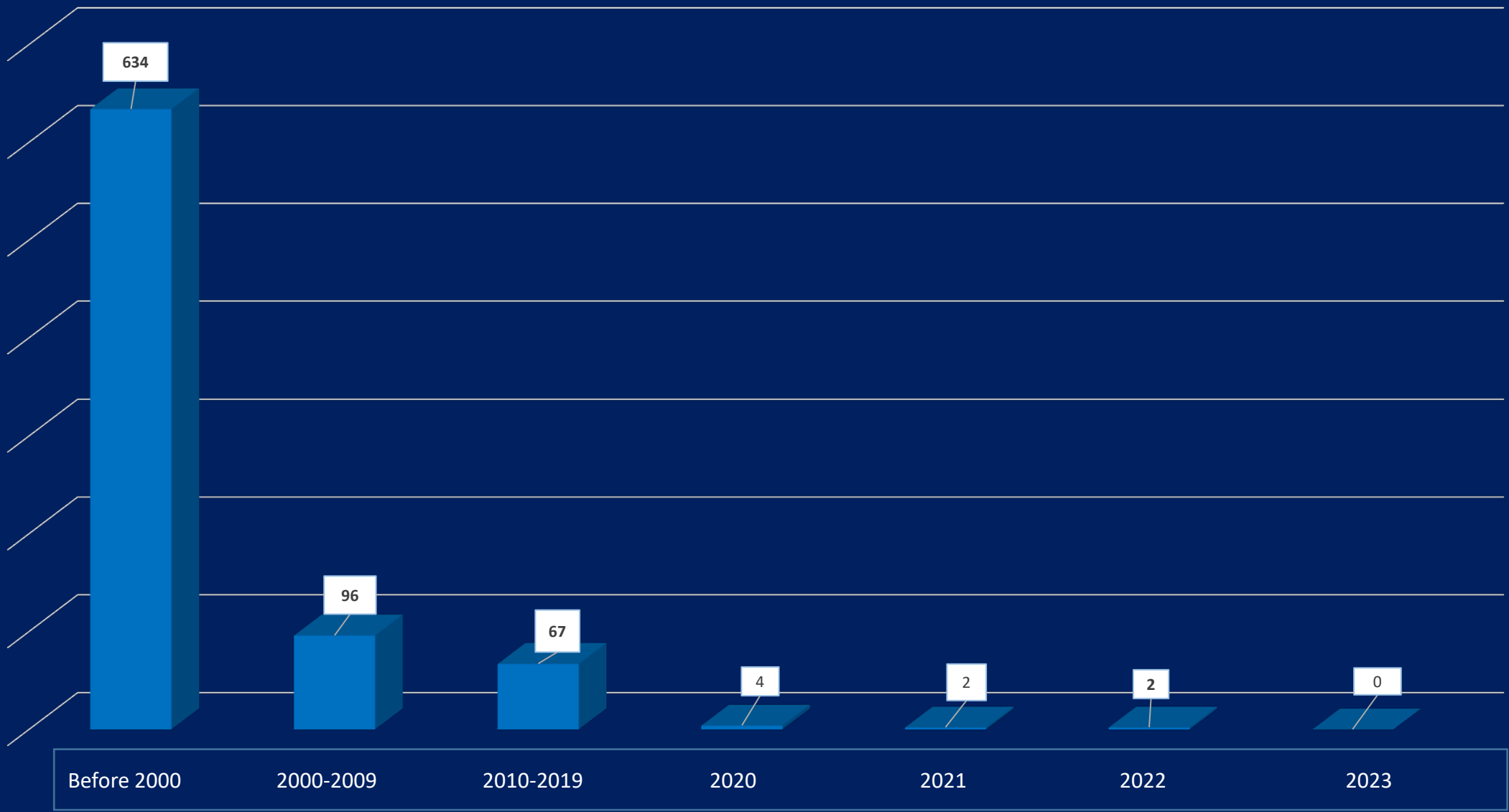
1. Areas cleared from mines and EOs, where different development projects are carried out.
2. Safe behavior formed among the population.
3. Adoption of “not harming the environment” policy during the clearance operations.
4. Restored or newly established infrastructure.
5. Increased level of food security and general standard of population livelihood through the implementation of socio-economic programs in the bordering communities.
