### Supporting Ukraine's demining efforts since 2015

- Over \$80 million committed since the full-scale invasion
- Assistance channelled through stabilization, defence and development funding mechanisms
- Direct support to Ukrainian state demining institutions
- Partnering with experienced international mine action organizations
- Joining efforts with other donors (US)
